**NSA Central Region Early Gathering on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> January 2019**  
**Information and conditions for trade stands**

Stand charges are listed on the application form. Please indicate clearly the size of stand required.

The closing date for stand applications is Friday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2018. Applications received after this date will be subject to space availability.

Each company shall exhibit only or mainly materials and products of relevance to agriculture and related industries.

No exhibitors shall be permitted to arrange their stand or to place their sign in such a manner as to obstruct the light or to inconvenience or disadvantageously affect the display of any other exhibitor. No form of intrusion into neighbouring sites will be permitted.

Electricity can only be provided for inside stands as indicated on the application form. All electrical equipment must have been PAT tested in the last 12 months. Water standpipes will be available on site.

All indoor stand space is on clean, flat concrete or hardcore. Outdoor space is available on hardstanding. Exhibitors with marquees must speak to the organiser before booking trade stand space.

Exhibitors shall furnish their stand with a fire extinguisher.

Exhibitors shall be responsible for the removal of refuse from their stand.

Stand holders will be sent two exhibitor passes for one small outdoor or indoor stand booked, and four free passes for larger outdoor stands booked. Three extra passes can be obtained for a total of £10 plus VAT at time of booking space. Two vehicle passes will be issued to allow access for off-loading but is not a parking permit.

Access for erection of stands will be from 12 noon to 8pm on Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2019 but those on site can continue with stand erection. All non-exhibition items and cars must be off site by 9 am on the day of the event. All articulated vehicles unloading stand equipment for indoor stands must be unloaded on Wednesday morning by prior arrangement with the organiser. Stands can be removed after 5pm on the day of the event.

Staffing of stands must be at all times between 10am and 4.30pm on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> January.

No person other than an exhibitor who has applied for and been allocated space will be allowed to sell or display articles of any description on the site. Sub-letting of stands is not permitted.
