

Summary of the changes . . .

One CPH number for separate pieces of land located within a 10 mile radius



End to SOAs

New process for registering temporary land

Sheep – batch recording for slaughter animals only (2018)

End to CTS links

CPH timetable

Business As Usual (2017/18)

1/1/2018

Certain within business reporting exemptions for sheep moves end on this date i.e.



- frequent e.g. open gate moves
- Batch reporting of moves if to a different CPH within same keepership

July 2016

APHA / RPA start sending detailed letters to all directly affected businesses (c. 30,000)

(Keepers with CTS links will then get a call ①)



Summer / Autumn 2017

Send last batch of detailed letters out to affected keepers



May 2016

Letter to all keepers

(Same level of information as in these slides)





Transition as at 8th February 2017 ...

- 30,000 livestock businesses may be affected by one or more of the changes
 - 43% of businesses have been transitioned
 - 16% are in progress
- The aim is to have business transitioned by Summer/Autumn 2017
- 10,500 CTS links 54% have been closed
- 83,600 tCPHs 42% closed
- 18,600 SOAs 43% closed
- 2,579 TLAs approved (covering 24,901 land parcels)
- 539 new tCPHs approved (covering 2,659 land parcels)
