Application form to sell tickets for the NSA Scottish Region raffle to win a Honda TRX 420FM1 ATV

NSA Scottish Region holds a licence from the Local Authority to run this raffle, which is to win a Honda TRX 420FM1 ATV. In line with NSA Scottish Region running the raffle and Honda's priorities, the raffle is to be promoted primarily in Scotland. However, any UK resident can buy a ticket, which are £1 each and available in books of five. More information, terms and conditions are at www.nsascotland.org/raffle.

Sheep breed societies affiliated to NSA are incentivised to sell tickets on behalf of NSA Scottish Region.

The process is:-

1. Use this form to apply for tickets to sell.
2. Promote the raffle however you can, including by requesting a Honda TRX 420FM1 ATV to display at any events or sales you are holding. Honda is able to supply, free of charge, a demonstration ATV if you let Damian Butterworth (damian.butterworth@honda-eu.com) know dates, locations and contact details two to three weeks in advance. In addition to requesting the bike, you can download promotional materials at www.nsascotland.org/raffle.
3. Return unsold and sold tickets and the correct money in a sealed envelope clearly marked with the name of your breed society. This needs to be returned to Euan Emslie, NSA Scottish Region, 3 Briar Close, Newport, HU15 2QY, by **Friday 14th June 2019**, or handed to Euan in the NSA Scottish Region marquee at the Royal Highland Show by 3pm on Sunday 23rd June 2019. Cheques should be made payable to NSA Scotsheep.
4. NSA Scottish Region will contact you after the raffle has been held to offer to **gift back 60%** of the proceeds from the number of tickets you have sold.
5. NSA Scottish Region and Honda will contact the breed society that has sold the most tickets so Honda can gift an **EU22 generator** (including its delivery).
6. If the winning ticket was sold by a breed society, NSA Scottish Region will invite you to be part of the photo shoot / post-affle publicity when the ATV is presented to the winner. Information and photos will be shared through NSA communication routes and made available for the breed society for its own use.

Data protection information for any individual or breed society selling tickets

Information written on the ticket stubs (purchaser's name, address etc) is protected under GDPR and must be handled appropriately. Therefore, anyone selling tickets on behalf of NSA Scottish Region must keep completed ticket stubs secure in accordance with GDPR legislation until they are securely transferred to NSA Scottish Region. They must also sign the agreement overleaf to say they will not copy, share or retain any data collected via the the ticket stubs. Once received, ticket stubs will be processed and stored by NSA Scottish Region and NSA Head Office in accordance with GDPR and the [NSA Privacy Policy](#). Non-compliance with GDPR could lead to a hefty fine and legal action from the Information Commissioner's Office.
