The Judge Mr John Uffold of McCartneys Ludlow said he “enjoyed the task of Judging”. Class 1 Native Upland was won by the Llandovery Whiteface from Wendy Morgan, Nantgwynne, and the Joseph family from the Lloney gaining second place with a pair Brecknock Hill Cheviots. Unfortunately there were no entries in class 2 native lowland. Moving on to Class 3 the continental, again quality was on offer. The winner of this class was Mrs Owen fferm y Banc with her Roussin, second place again went to the Joseph family with pure texels and Wendy Morgan gained third with her Pedigree Beltex.

After the show it was then down to the sale conducted by McCartneys LLP Brecon with the commission being donated to a charity. The ring was packed. Top call of 880gns was from Mr David Pittendreigh’ plas villa. This pair has caused a lot of interest throughout the day and was finally knocked down to Mrs Williams Green Lane, Devon. In the money next was Wendy Morgan with her Pedigree Beltex selling at 350gns to Hywell Williams, Llandovery. The Joseph family then sold both pairs of Brecknock Hill Cheviots at 160gns to Gwilym Williams taking both lots. Mr Molyneux a well known breeder of Roussin fancied Mrs Owen Roussin and purchased them at 150gns. Overall the sale was pleasing with only missing on 4 lots.
